### **Outcome of the conference participation**

Outcome of the Conference participation:

- I co-authored as first author (second authors were Catarina Costeira, PT and Ania Stan, RO) two oral presentations disseminating news about the up to date progress in the development of the EuroWeb Atlas – one of the most important deliverables of the EuroWeb COST Action and about the Romanian heritage databases containing textile resources

- I co-organised together with Catarina Costeira and Francisco B. Gomez, PT, the EAA Session 232. *Dressing Europe: Mapping and Disseminating European Textile Heritage through Digital Resources in Open Archaeology*, with 10 presentations and a poster.

Contacts that I established during my participation at the 28th EAA Annual Meeting in Budapest and the potential for future collaboration:

- I had the chance to meet Catarina Costeira (archaeologist at UNIARQ, PT) in person and to plan together with her future collaborations, including the co-authorship for 2 papers on the topics related with the EuroWeb Digital Atlas (one to be published in the Periodical Journal of the National Institute of Heritage of Romania and another one to be prepared for the publication of the Session that we organised at EAA).
- Together with Catarina Costeira and Francisco B. Gomez we made a preliminary plan for the publication of the EAA Session *Dressing Europe: Mapping and Disseminating European Textile Heritage through Digital Resources in Open Archaeology* Journal published by De Gruyter.
- I had a preliminary discussion about organising a 3 days EuroWeb Digital Atlas hackathon in Vienna in 2023 in collaboration with Karina Grömer from the Naturhistorisches Museum. This hackathon will focus on the preparation and import of large sets of textile data from Central Europe in the Atlas.
- I exchanged ideas and received feedback during the presentation of the EuroWeb Digital Atlas and the presentation of a heritage database from Romania that contains heritage resources that are currently being imported into the Atlas.
- Learning about other databases around Europe and about different methodologies of cataloguing and mapping of heritage resources.
- I had the possibility to visit the EAA Fair to learn about the newest books in the field of textiles and to discuss about the possibility to publish academic papers in the *Antiquity* Journal.
