The session co-organized by myself (main organizer) and Anne Kwaspen was a success. We had 6 papers presented (both online and onsite) and a wide audience that actively participated in the discussion on the use of textiles, leather, straw, plants, reeds, seaweed etc. in tombs and their significance in burial customs.

The session covered a wide geographical area of the eastern Mediterranean (Greece, Slovenia and Egypt) and a wide chronological frame (from the 7<sup>th</sup> century BC to the Roman era). A number of EuroWeb members attended the conference both online and onsite, something that made the textile networking even stronger. After the end of the conference the editors of the book series *Global Perspectives on Ancient Mediterranean Archaeology*, published with Routledge, showed interest in publishing the proceedings of
